



#### PRICING\* AND SEATING



Children under 3 are FREE when sat on an adult's knee.

- \* Your group will be sitting in raked, stadium style, plastic seats.
- \*\* Your group will be sitting in raked, fully padded seats, with wider spacing between each seat

### ACCESS AND MOBILITY

For wheelchair users, there is an area reserved just in front of row A at surface level, with a seat in row A just behind for their essential companion.

All wheelchair users must be accompanied by an essential companion who is entitled to an admission ticket at no additional cost, but they must be able to physically undertake all access requirements on behalf of their companion (documentation required).

Other visitors in the same party will be seated as close as possible, subject to availability, in rows behind

### **GETTING AROUND**

From our welcome plaza, there is a flat level surface for the 450 metre walk to the tribune (seating and performance area) and plenty of low level lighting.

The tribune is standard raked style seating and depending on where your seats are, there may be shallow steps to climb.

There are several seating options to choose from. Book early to secure your choice from the 8,000 seater tribune.

#### Standard\*

On the far left- and right-hand sides of the tribune. Further from the very centre of the action but well placed to take in the bigger picture as the whole spectacle unfolds.

#### Superior\*

You won't miss a thing in these seats as you'll be well placed to see the action coming right towards you.

These seats have you close to the heart of the show. just to the left and right of the central block.

A luxury seat with a little more space between you and your neighbour with wider, cushioned seat, right in the middle of the tribune for the most immersive, up-close and personal experience on offer.

### **FOOD AND DRINK**



There is a variety of delicious food and drink options available pre-show to enjoy and plenty of picnic benches.

VIP Dining Experiences are also available in the Arches Hall with it's exclusive lakeside terrace. This has limited availability so do book early.

#### WEATHER
